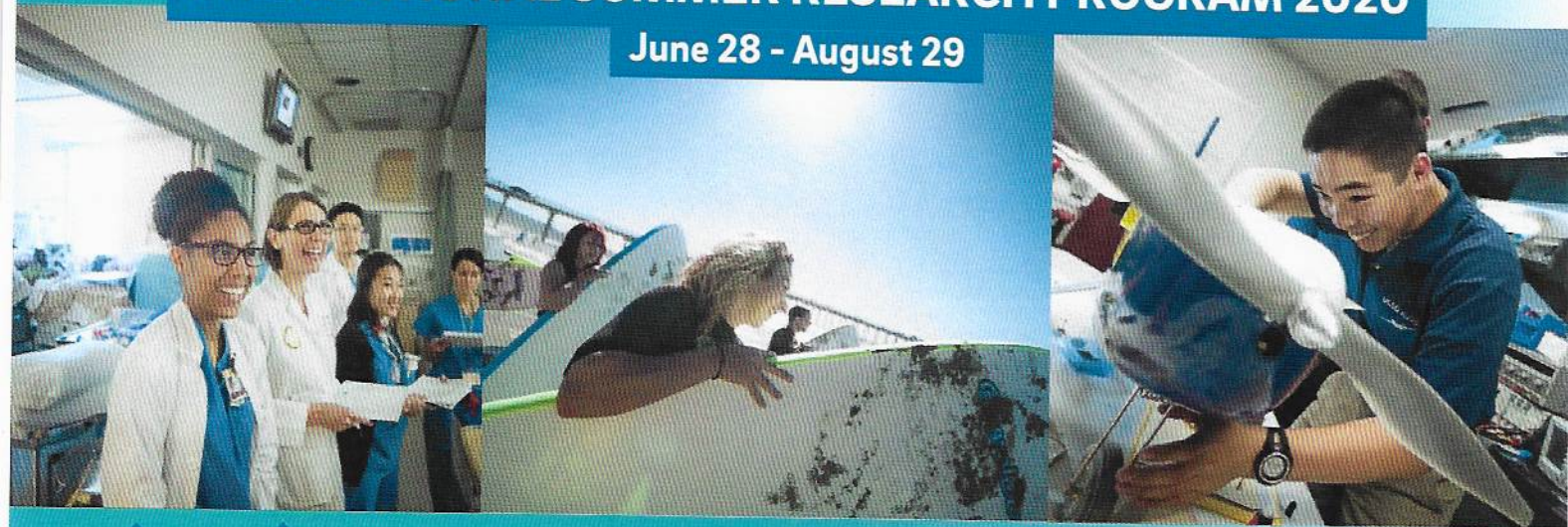

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The International Summer Research Program (ISRP) is a rigorous 8-10 week program that invites international students from partner universities to join labs of leading UC San Diego faculty and engage in cutting-edge research. In addition to gaining valuable research experience, students will have the opportunity to explore San Diego and engage in cultural outings with students from around the world. At the end of the program, students will present their research findings at the 2020 ISRP Research Symposium. ISRP is open to students of ALL majors!
